Receipt Review and Award

- 1) <http://grants1.nih.gov/grants/funding/submissionschedule.htm> Standard due dates for Competing Applications – check for Scientific Merit Review date based on the Cycle (I-III) e.g. April application of F31 is reviewed June/July. Also, 1 month before is standard for submitting any additional materials or updates (sponsor's funding, new publications, awards, etc.), but verify ahead of time with Scientific Review Officer for that Study Section.
